

BOARDING

Central Animal Hospital accommodates four-legged overnight guests - including cats, dogs, exotics, and pocket pets - 365 days a year. Our accommodations are designed to ensure a safe, comfortable, and healthy environment for your pet. The boarding experience is customized to each meet each pet's needs. Our caring staff observes all of our guests throughout the day, and our facility is protected by security monitoring after-hours.

Boarding Overview

All boarded pets are fed a high-quality diet, in accordance with the owner's instructions. Fresh bedding is provided; bedding from home may become damaged or soiled, so we ask that clients leave their pets' own beds at home. Pets being boarded at the clinic enjoy exercise at regular intervals throughout the day. Dogs get individual walks and play time in an enclosed outdoor yard, and feline guests are given time to romp in our kitty play area.

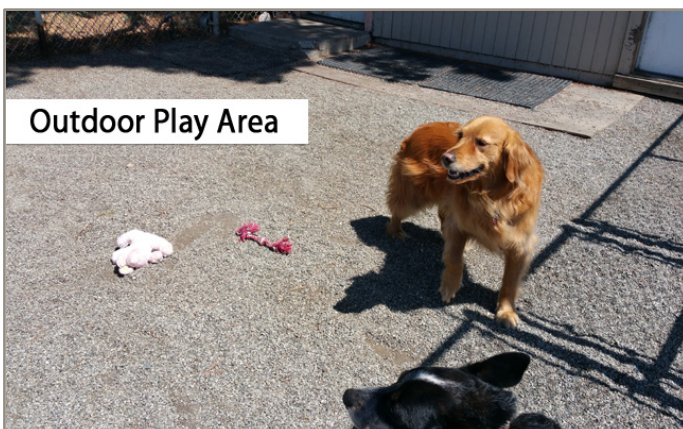
Medical Boarding

Pets requiring an extra level of care can benefit from the medical expertise of our veterinary staff. If your pet is currently taking medication, our team will administer medications on the prescribed schedule*. We can also accommodate pets' special dietary requirements by feeding any special food that the owner supplies.

Veterinary Services For Boarders

For your convenience, any medical services you're anticipating for your pet - from major surgery to dental cleanings - can be performed during your pet's stay at the clinic; simply let our staff know in advance of your pet's check-in date. We are also happy to take care of your pet's grooming needs during their visit. The boarding fee is waived for the day of departure if you request to include a bath or full grooming in your boarding package.

The boarding experience at Central Animal Hospital is customized to meet the care needs of each furry guest, including those requiring daily medical management.

Boarding Multiple Pets

Families with multiple pets have the option of boarding two pets in a shared space, (provided the animals are of the same species and "play nice"). When sharing accommodations, the second pet may be boarded for a reduced daily rate (see rates above). Our staff reserves the right to separate pets being boarded together if fighting occurs.

Exam & Vaccine Requirements

At the time of check-in, dogs must be current for Rabies (one- or three-year), Distemper (one- or three-year), and Bordetella (six-month) vaccines. Cats must be current for Rabies (one-year) and Distemper (one- or three-year). We will accept proof of vaccination from other veterinarians. All of our guests must have had an exam from one of Central Animal Hospital's doctors within the previous 12-month period. If your pet requires vaccinations or an exam, these can be scheduled ahead of time or performed upon your pet's arrival for boarding.



Check-In & Departure Information

Pets may be checked in anytime during regular clinic hours: M – F from 7am-7pm, Sat from 7am-5pm, Sun from 8am-4pm. A boarding fee will apply for the date of arrival. Check-out time is 12pm. The boarding fee will be waived for the date of departure if your pet is picked up by 12pm and/or if your pet received a bath or grooming service during his or her stay.



Central Animal Hospital is closed for arrivals and departures on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Easter, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas. The clinic closes early on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve.
